I WOULD LIKE TO RENEW MY NOTARY PUBLIC COMMISSION. IS THE APPLICATION PROCESS THE SAME FOR RENEWAL?

NO—an applicant who wishes to renew his or her notary is not required to take the oral test again.

- * Apply for a renewal no sooner than 30 days prior to the expiration date of your notary.
- * Complete the application and fill in the date of your Notary Public expiration.
- * If your commission has expired prior to your application for renewal, you will be required to complete the affidavit on the back of the application and sign it.
- * Your application will be signed by the Judge of the Common Pleas Court and may be picked up at the Clerk of Courts office or mailed to you at your request.
- * Follow the same steps as for new notary applicants from this point.

WHERE DO I OBTAIN MY NOTARY PUBLIC SEAL?

Your Notary Public seal and rubber stamp may be obtained through an office supplies store/dealer.
